

GALLON MEASUREMENT CONVERSION ACTIVITY

Materials:

1 blank sheet of white paper per student

7-8 different colored pens, crayon, markers or pencils per student

Procedure:

1. Read these instructions one at a time to the students, allowing them to follow along. Create the same drawing on the white board with as many different colors as available as the students create theirs.

<u>Color 1</u>- draw a thick border around the page

<u>Color 2</u>- divide the box into 4. You now have 4 quadrants.

<u>Color 3</u>- divide one of those quadrants in 2.

<u>Color 4</u>- divide one of those boxes (color 3) in 2. Divide two quadrants in 4. You should still have one blank quadrant.

<u>Color 5</u>- Pick one square in quadrant 4 and divide into 8.

<u>Color 6-</u> Pick one square in quadrant 4 and divide into 16.

Color 7- Pick one square in quadrant 4 and divide into 48. Leave one quadrant blank

- 2. Go back and label the boxes
- 1 gallon
- 4 quarts
- 2 pints
- 2 cups
- 4 cups
- 8 ounces
- 16 tablespoons
- 48 teaspoons
